Register for the "HAC"

The HomeScouting Adventure Club is FREE for all Buckeye Council families and registering is simple! While this is a free program for Buckeye Council families, all participants must still register for the program on a simple Google Form and then create an account on homescouting.org.

To register, each family must:

1. Go to www.buckeyecouncil.org/HAC to find the Buckeye Council registration form
2. Fill out the Google Form to register your family for the HomeScouting Adventure Club
3. Then go to www.homescouting.org and click on **Log In** in the top right-hand corner
4. If you have an account, great! If not click **Sign Up**.
5. Create an account
6. You will automatically be enrolled in the HomeScouting Adventure Club!
